30 Days to Family® Quick Overview

30 Days to Family[®] is an intense, short-term intervention developed by the Foster & Adoptive Care Coalition and replicated nationally by the Institute for Child Welfare Innovation to:

1) increase the number of children placed with relatives when they enter the foster care system; and

2) ensure natural and community supports are in place to promote stability for the child.

The program is a combination family search and engagement & kinship navigator.

WHAT WOULD YOU DO FOR YOUR OWN FAMILY?

The 30 Days to Family® rigorous search process identifies and engages more relatives, faster – helping children have greater connection to their siblings, more involvement with their paternal relatives, and find stable homes with relatives within 30 days.

Once children are placed with family, our robust support plans for both the children and placement providers promote placement stability and solidify connections that create better outcomes for children, families, and the communities we call home.


Two families at one time. That's it. With dedication to those families, the focus is truly on them.

> 30 days. Period. We get in, we do the work, and we hand off. Urgency is key.

Connections and supports are key. Gone are the days of looking only for placement.

The system is tough to navigate. We help families access, map and sustain every service they need. Contact with all family members. Every single one. They all have something to contribute.

Specialized worker for specialized work. One person doing all the jobs just isn't possible.





- Every child served by 30 Days to Family[®] saves taxpayers an average of \$10,217
- Every child served age 9 years and older saves taxpayers an average of \$21,686
- Every child served who has an identified disability saves taxpayers an average of \$28,819

PROVEN SAVINGS

The savings referenced are based on Missouri case rates

PROVEN OUTCOMES

- Relative Placement. Children served by 30 Days to Family[®] were more likely to be placed with a relative or kin than those not served.
- Less time in care. Children served by 30 Days to Family® remained in foster care an average 91.4 fewer days; those age 9 years and older were in care an average 194 fewer days; and those with an identified disability were in care an average 257.8 fewer days.
- Increased placement stability. For children served by 30 Days to Family[®], placement change rates were reduced by 81% after being placed with relatives.

A second study was conducted in Ohio counties replicating the model demonstrated consistent results.

Even More Evidence!

In Ohio, the program has saved an average of \$13,194 per child, and the children served...

• were 88.4% less likely to experience a placement

In reviewing data from the Foster & Adoptive Care Coalition 30 Days to Family[®] site from the beginning of the program in March 2011 through December 2021 we found some heartening data:

Placement Rate: 801 of 1058 children served were placed with family at the conclusion of services

Placement Stability: Of those 801 children placed with family, 664 children remained placed with family at the most recent follow-up

Promoting Family Placement: Sometimes despite best efforts, children aren't moved with family during the program intervention. The remarkable thing is that the work done was not for nothing. 75 of the 257 children that were not placed with family at the conclusion of services had achieved family placement at the time of the most recent follow-up!






